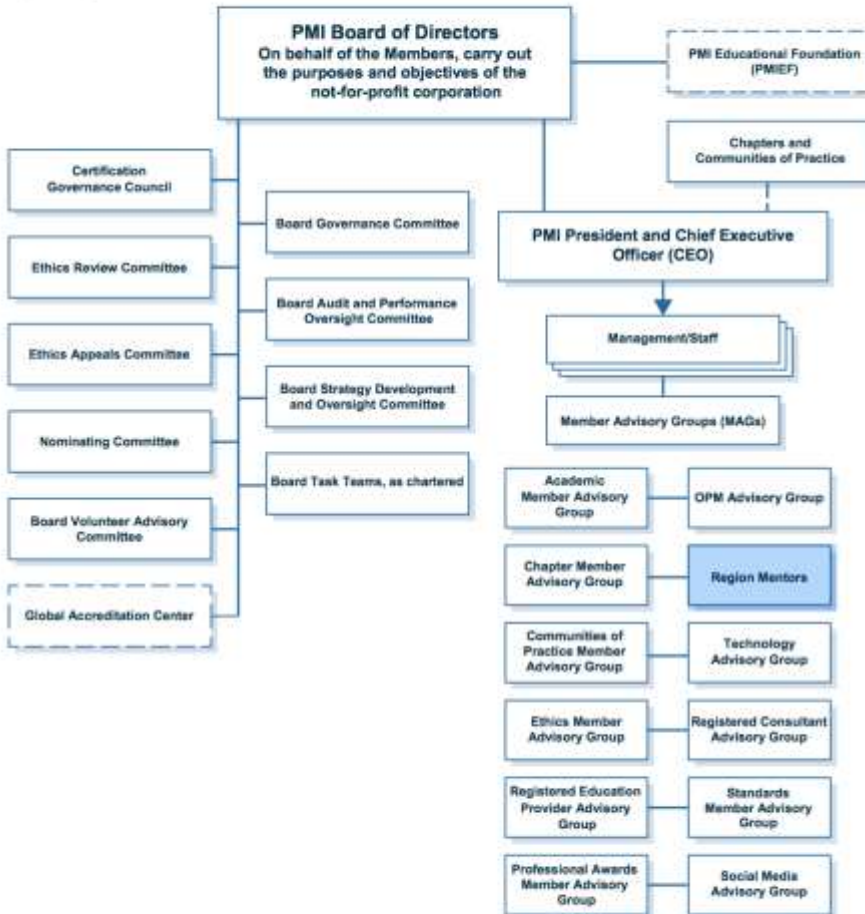

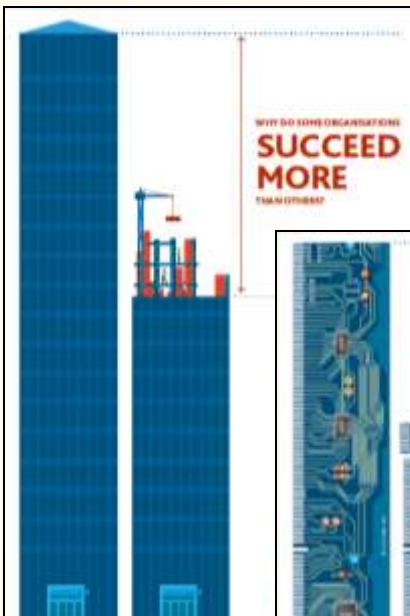

PMI's Talent Triangle

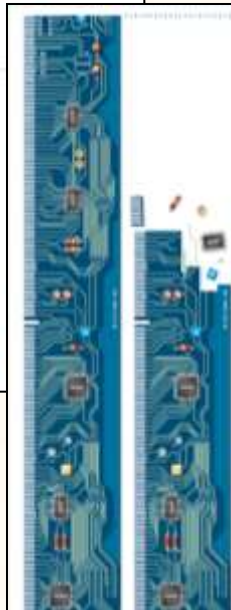
