

- Firsts: Email distribution, Letterhead, Dinner program
- 5-person committee ran everything
- Volunteers scarce
- 40-50 members (info came on floppy disk)
- \$0 in bank







#### William M. Hayden Jr. - 3rd

- Introduced guest speakers at meetings
- "Pioneers"
- Breathed new life into a chapter that was preparing to shut down
- West Valley members most active

#### **Brian Lang – 5th**

- Established full program line-up
- Started Breakfast roundtable
