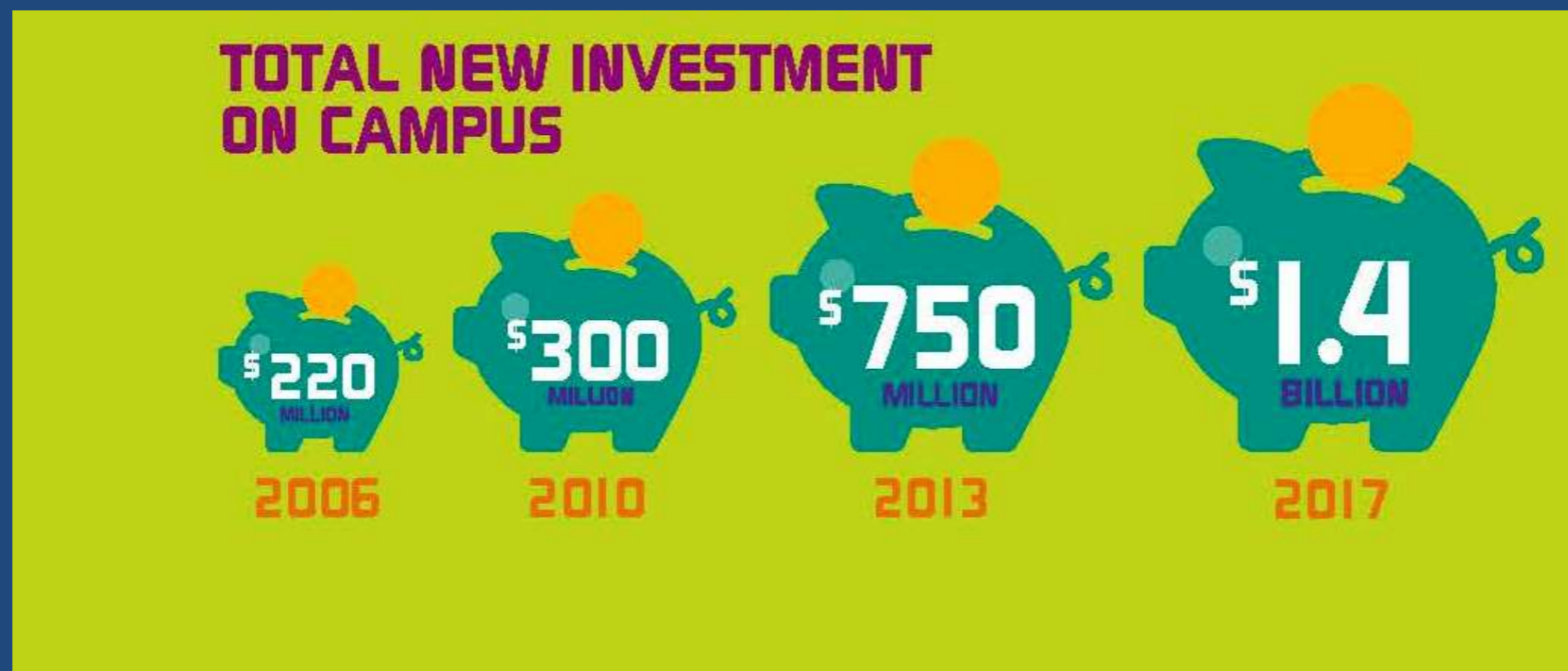


- The 120-acre Campus includes a dynamic consortium of world-class hospitals, health care facilities, research and educational institutions, and a growing list of public and private institutions.

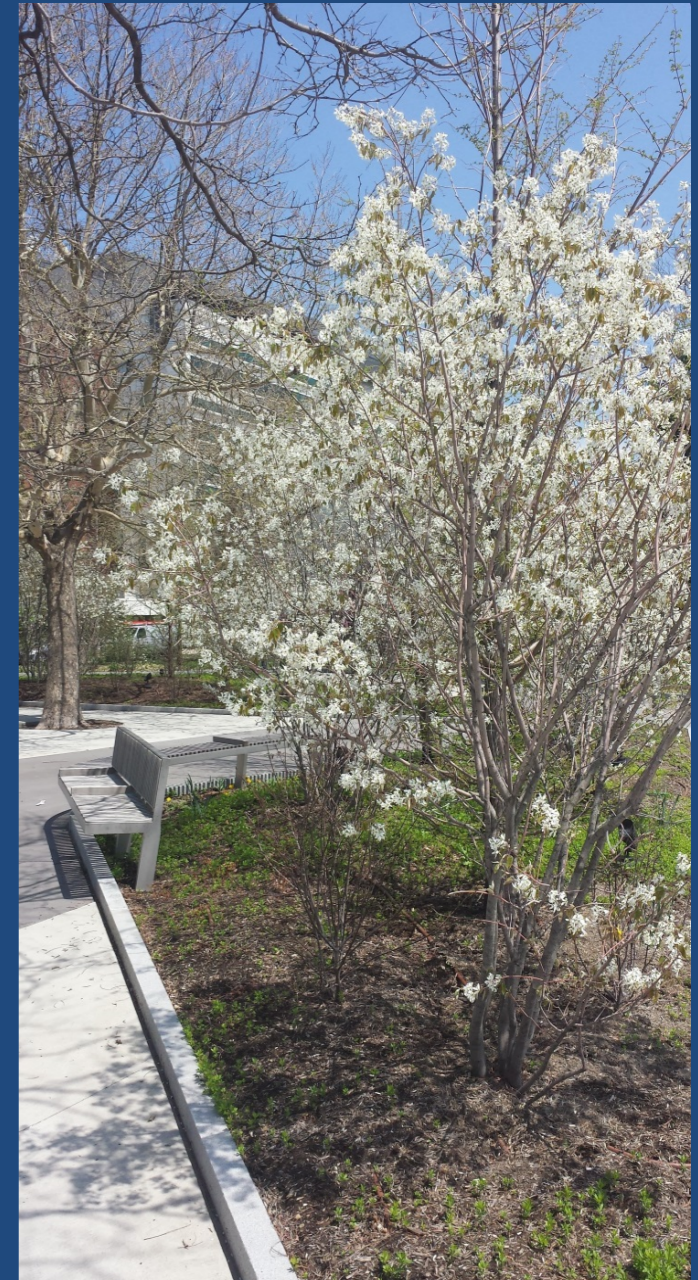

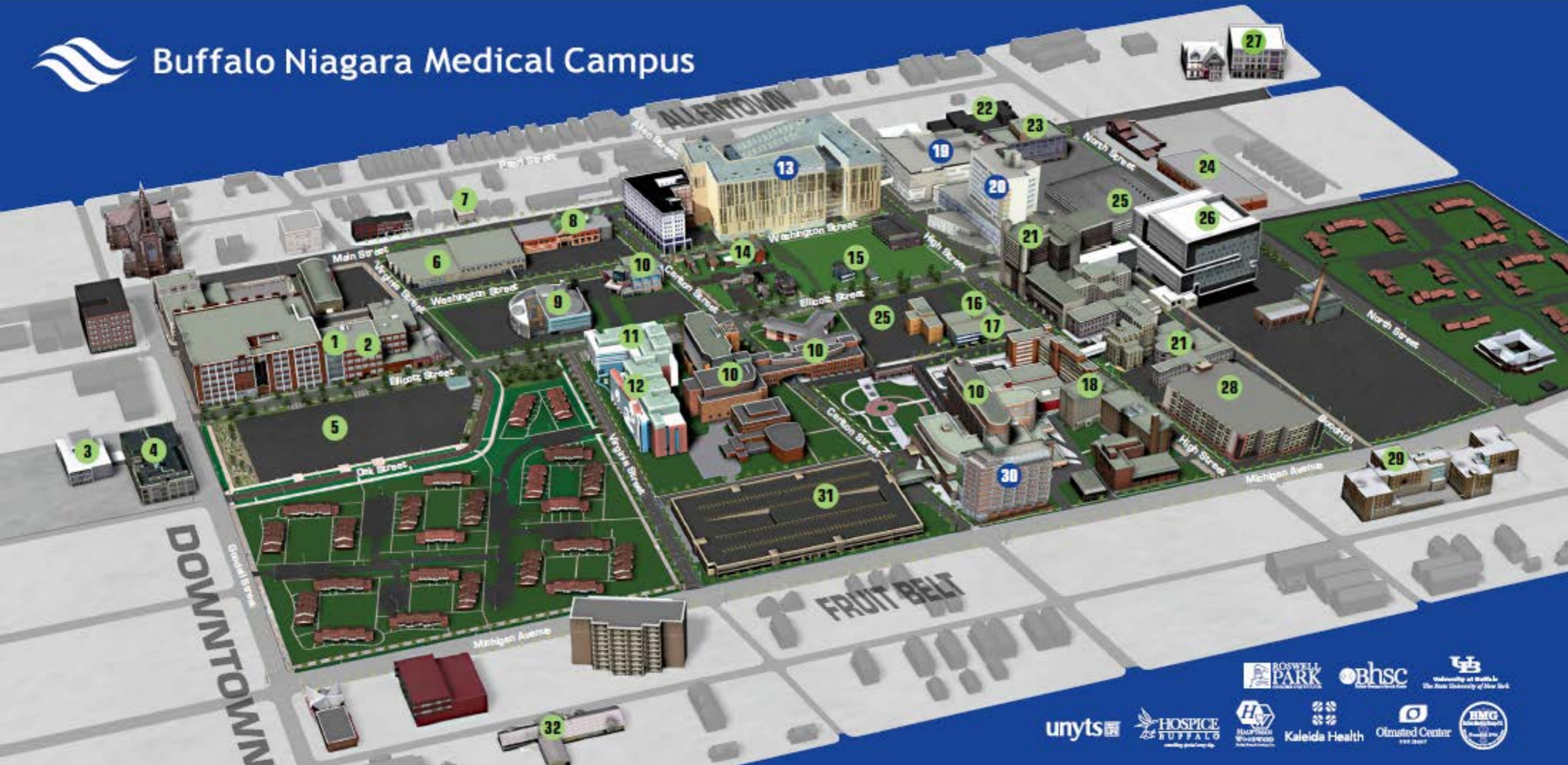
